2017 AGC GULF COAST CLASSIC FISHING TOURNAMENT RULES

2 DIVISIONS:

1. NON-GUIDED - 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place
2. GUIDED - 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place

PRIZES

- Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third place in the following categories:
 - Heaviest Stringer (1 trout and 1 redfish), Heaviest Trout, and Heaviest Redfish
 - A fish can only be entered into one of the three categories of the 2 Divisions
1. **Captain's Meeting**- Thursday, August 10th at Louie's Backyard at 6pm; one person from your team or your driver/guide MUST attend. This is mandatory.
 2. **Check In and Weigh In at Louie's Backyard.** All boats need to be weighed in by 3 pm.
 3. **Awards Banquet & Dinner at Louie's Backyard at 6:00 pm.**
 4. **Stringer**- The team stringer consists of 1 trout and 1 redfish. Put these fish in the team's fish bag provided at weigh in. Coolers will not be allowed in the weigh in area, they are allowed in the line.
 5. **Fishing License**- You must have a valid/current fishing license from Texas Parks & Wildlife to fish in the tournament. Please fish this tournament by the rules enforced by Texas Parks & Wildlife. A citation will disqualify you from the tournament.
 6. **One Pole per Angler**- You can have more than one rod and reel on the boat, but you cannot fish with more than one at a time.
 7. **Team**- This is an amateur fishing tournament. Up to four men/women and one guide per boat. All individuals on the boat must be listed on the registration form. **GUIDES** may assist you in baiting your hook, casting, and "Netting" the catch. It is your job to "Set the hook" and reel in the fish to the boat or net.
 8. **Fishing Boundaries**- NONE. You can fish from a boat or wade but you must remain insight of boat.
 9. **Time**- Fishing begins at 7:00 am on Friday, August 11th. Weigh in not earlier than 12pm and all boats must be in line no later than 3:00 pm.
 10. **Ties**- In the event of a weight tie, length will prevail and if there is a tie in the length, time of weigh in will prevail. **Decisions of the weigh master are final.**
 11. **Refusal**- Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse application of entry, with or without cause, at its sole discretion. Any applicant refused entry shall be entitled to a refund of their entry fee.
 12. **Altering Fish**- The fish weighed in cannot be altered in any way. Tails cannot be cut, nothing can be stuffed in them, and they must be fresh and caught on tournament day.
 13. **Polygraph**- All contestants agree to take a polygraph test if required by an AGC Representative or the AGC Weigh Master. Such a test shall be taken at the time and place requested by the AGC. Failure to take or pass a polygraph will result in disqualification from this tournament. The individual taking the test may be a team member or the boat guide/driver.
 14. **If you have ever been disqualified from any fishing tournament, you will not be qualified to fish in an AGC tournament.**
 15. **Bait**- Any bait can be used.
 16. Team of 4, max 4 fishermen per boat. If a guide is used, they are not allowed to fish and will not be counted as a fisherman.
 17. You must be present to win the raffle prize.
 18. To put items into the contestant goody bags you must at least be a Bronze Sponsor (\$500).
